

Focusing on Jesus is the key to joy, even during times of distress.

Philippians 1:1-8

The apostle Paul demonstrated that spiritual joy is possible even during times of adversity. In fact, his epistle to the Philippians, written during a time of imprisonment, is known for its repeated references to rejoicing. But have you ever felt as if you've lost your joy? This can happen for several reasons:

- Wrong focus. By centering on Jesus, Paul was able to praise God despite harsh trials. Concentrating on difficulties can cause delight to vanish. Refocus through praise to bring it back.
- Disobedience. Sin steals our joy because it disrupts our fellowship with God (<u>Ps.</u> 66:18). As we receive His forgiveness and obey Him, joy returns.
- Regret. We crowd out gladness when we dwell on past mistakes. The Lord has forgiven us (1 John 1:9). He wants us to choose to live in His grace and move ahead.
- Fear. Joy and fear cannot coexist. We are called to live by faith, asking God to meet today's needs and trusting Him with the future.
- Others' suffering. How can we rejoice when others hurt? Romans 12:15 says we're to weep with them, but we are also to offer the hope of God's presence, power, and provision.

A consistently downcast spirit is a poor witness for hope (Ps. 42:11). Fix your gaze on the Savior and let His joy become yours. Then it can overflow to those around you.

I pray that every eye that reads this knows there is no problem, no circumstance or situation greater than God; and I pray that these words be received into the hearts of every eye that sees it in Jesus' name. Amen!

Thank you Lord for your grace and mercy!

Rio Texas Annual Conference June 8-11, 2022 Lay Delegate to Annual Conference Report

The Eighth Session of the Rio Texas Conference was convened by Bishop Robert Schnase on June 9, 2022. Following a Service of Worship, the First Plenary Session was called to order, the organization of the conference was explained, the bar was established, and the Agenda, the Consent Agenda and the Consent Agenda II was adopted.

In lieu of learning sessions, this year's Annual Conference featured Learn & Serve opportunities which highlighted many of the local ministries supported by the United Methodist Church.

During the plenary sessions, the following action items were approved:

Standing Rules - No major changes were made.

<u>Finance Table Reports I-IV</u> – The Finance Table was given authority to adjust the budget during the coming year; the minimum salary for clergy was increased slightly; the 2023 Proposed Budget represents a .045% increase from the 2022 Approved Budget.

<u>Finance Table Report VI</u> – Equitable Compensation Policies which were adopted in 2014 were updated to keep the salaries of those previously serving in the Southwest Texas Conference and the Rio Grande Conference in alignment.

<u>Finance Table Report VII</u> – The use of Hispanic Ministries Funds was modified to clarify that grant funds are to be awarded to employers and not employees.

<u>Board of Pensions Reports I and II</u> – 3% increase in Past Service rate and changing references to "2021" to "2022". Report II clarified the tax status relating to housing allowances.

Harvest Sunday – Harvest Sunday has been set for November 6, 2022.

Methodist Healthcare Ministries - 2022-2023 Board Members were approved.

Board of Trustees, Report II - Disaffiliation of Jefferson UMC was approved.


