Providence Place is a professional adoption agency fully licensed by the state of Texas and recognized as a pioneer in open adoption with a reputation for integrity.


Food Pantry Giving

The Class Meeting

John Wesley, founder of Methodism, designed, as the heart of spiritual growth, a method of small groups called the Class Meeting. These groups met to give an account of their personal spiritual progress to one another from week to week.

Here at FUMC, our Class Meeting consists of a small group of folks who meet weekly. We are committed to Bible reading daily and attending the group regularly. Each meeting we ask



each other "How goes it with your soul?" Answers may be sharing part of a devotion that had meaning, or sharing that God was present, perhaps in a time of conflict, giving peace to a very troubled soul, or finding how to forgive something that seemed unforgiveable. Sometimes it is a very specific answer to prayers in one way or another, or confessing falling short on our reading. Our discussion can be very broad, or much more personal – it is up to the individual. Whatever is said, we are committed to keeping what is said in the group confidential. We have learned from each other and value the support and prayers of the group.

We invite you to join us and see where the Holy Spirit leads you. The group meets **Tuesdays at 4 p.m. in the Library**.

Christmas Mail

Have you heard of CHRISTMAS MAIL?

"Christmas Mail" will give you the opportunity to wish anyone in the Church a Merry Christmas or let them know

that they are in your prayers or any other message you might have for them. It can be on a Christmas card (either store-bought or hand-made) or it can be on a plain piece of paper. There will be "envelopes" decorated with Christmas wrapping paper hanging in the hallway outside the Sanctuary. There should be

an envelope for each family currently attending Church. (If there is not an envelope for your family, please let the Church office know so that we can get an envelope up for you immediately.) There will also be a numbered list of families which will be available **Sunday**, **December 4**th.



Electronic Giving

We will be transitioning to solely using Faith Teams for electronic giving. If you are currently setup to give through Vanco, you will need to

switch to Faith Teams. You will need to setup an account and then use **this link** to setup your giving. You can setup recurring giving using your credit/debit card or through your bank account. You can also choose to cover the processing fees. (See bottom right picture).

Currently, there are four ways to give through Faith Teams:

- 1. Free Mobile App You can download the free Faith Teams app, create an account and give directly from the app.
- 2. Text-to-give You can text 833-466-2140 with Give \$0 (enter any dollar amount). You must have an account setup to use text-to-give or it will prompt you to create an account. If you use a credit or debit card, fees may apply.
- 3. Giving Form You can use the online giving form <u>here</u> using your credit or debit card. Fees may apply.
- 4. On our website at fumcelgin.com Under the Giving tab, click the link that says, "Give Now".
